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Health System Innovation:

- **Online Appointment Booking (OAB) to Increase Cancer Screening.** Online Appointment Booking (OAB) enhances clinical efficiencies and is showing potential to increase uptake of cervical cancer screening appointments for patients. - In March 2023, Ontario Health- Cancer Care Ontario increased the target for colorectal cancer screening from 60 to 75%. Raising the bar for this target will contribute to a greater number of eligible patients who participate in the highly effective FIT colorectal screening program.
