### **Cancer Care Ontario Updates/Resources:**

• As shared in the June communique, the Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) has announced the following changes:

#### Breast Density Reporting and Notification

#### The following changes took effect on July 21, 2023

• The 1-year recall recommendation based on high breast density will change to be based on Breast Imaging Reporting and Data System (BI-RADS) breast density classification D, rather than percent mammographic density (PMD) ≥75%.

• All OBSP normal screening result letters will be updated to include a BI-RADS breast density classification (BI-RADS A-D) and will include a breast density fact sheet.

#### > Inclusion of People with Breast Implants in the OBSP

The following changes are targeted to take effect **October 16<sup>th</sup> 2023**:

• OBSP sites to begin screening people with breast implants in the OBSP.

• Public and provider webpages and other program materials will be updated to reflect the updated eligibility criteria.

#### Screening Trans and Nonbinary People in the OBSP

The following changes are targeted to take effect in October 2023:

• OBSP sites to begin screening eligible trans and nonbinary people according to guidance on improving screening for trans and nonbinary people in the OBSP.

• OBSP webpages and other program materials will be updated to reflect eligibility criteria.


