

Regional Cancer Program Updates:

- As a reminder, **Physician-Linked Correspondence** is available as a tool for physicians, which reminds enrolled patients to get screened. Below is an example of what your eligible patients receives regarding their cancer screening results.
 - With Physician Linked Correspondence, your name replaces "Judy Linton", making your patient more likely to action the request.
- Evidence demonstrates a positive relationship between physician recommendation for screening and patient participation in cancer screening. Benefits to physicians and screen-eligible Ontarians include:
 - Supports better patient care
 - o Maximizes the chances of early detection when cancer is easier to treat
 - o Saves the cost and time your practice spends calling or sending letters to patients






